



# PARTS OF SPEECH

## Noun

A word that represents a person, place, thing, or idea.  
Examples : **Dog, city, book, love**  
The **dog** chased its tail in circles.

## Verb

A word that describes an action, occurrence, or state of being. Examples : **Run, eat, sleep, is**  
She **loves** to **run** every morning.

## Adjective

A word that modifies or describes a noun or pronoun.  
Examples : **Beautiful, tall, delicious, happy**  
The sunset painted a **beautiful** scene across the sky.

## Adverb

A word that modifies or describes a verb, adjective, or another adverb. Examples: **Quickly, very, well, gently**  
He ran **quickly** to catch the bus

## Pronoun

A word used in place of a noun to avoid repetition.  
Examples : **He, she, they, it**  
John said **he** would be here soon.

## Preposition

A word that shows a relationship between a noun or pronoun and another word. Examples : **In, between**  
The book is **in** the drawer.

## Conjunction

A word that connects words, phrases, or clauses.  
Examples : **and, but, or, so**  
Sarah likes to read **and** write.

## Interjection

A word or phrase used to express strong emotion.  
Examples : **Wow, oh no, yay, oops**  
**Yikes!** I accidentally spilled coffee on my laptop.
